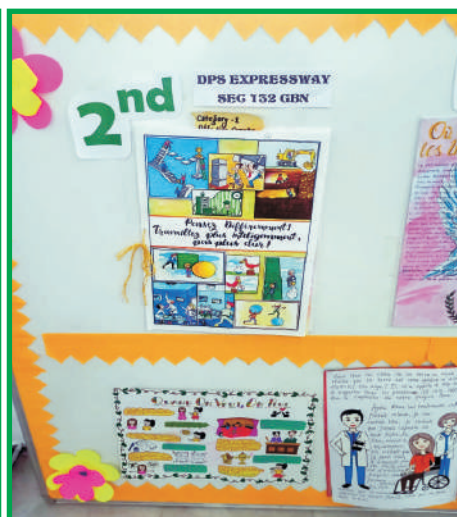


Annual Inter-School French Language Festival

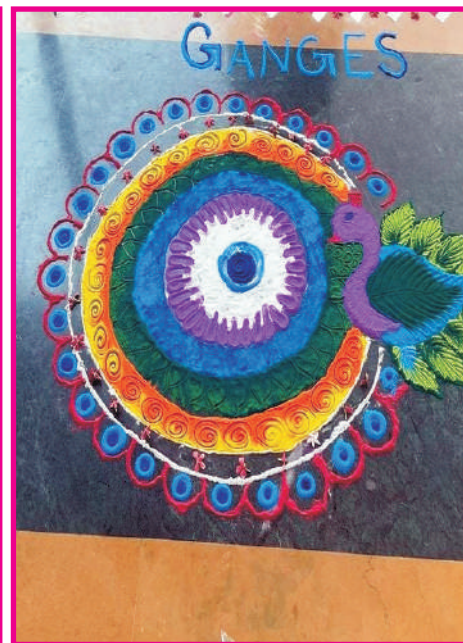
