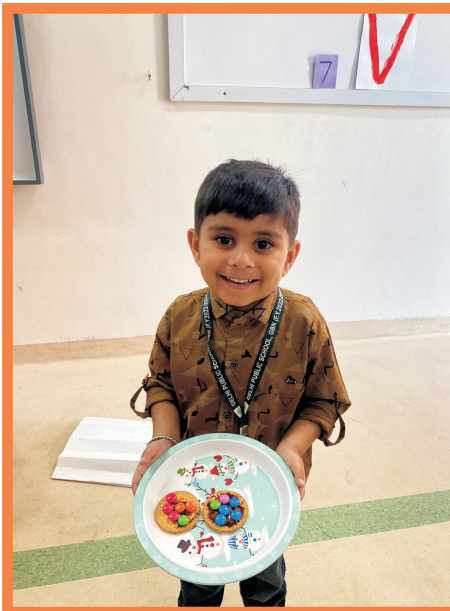

BROWN DAY

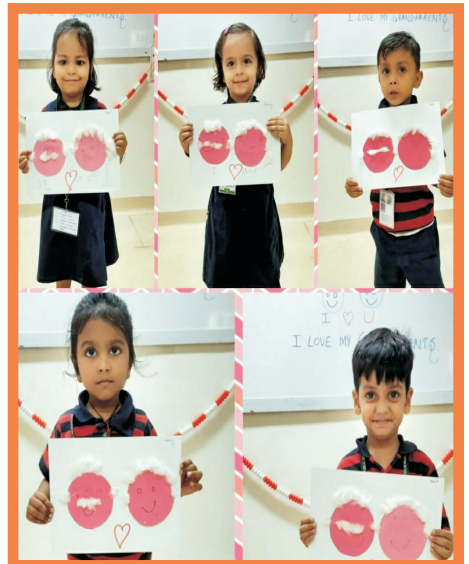
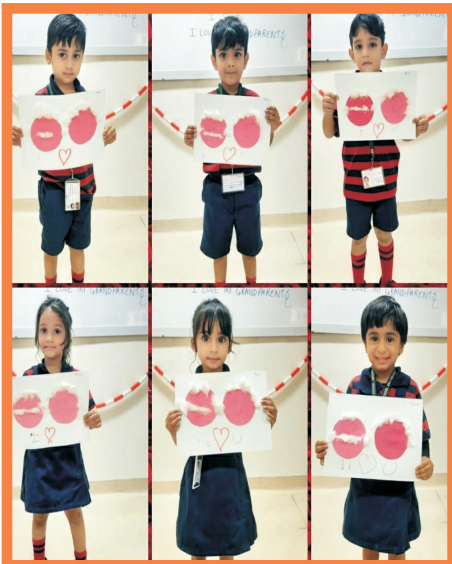
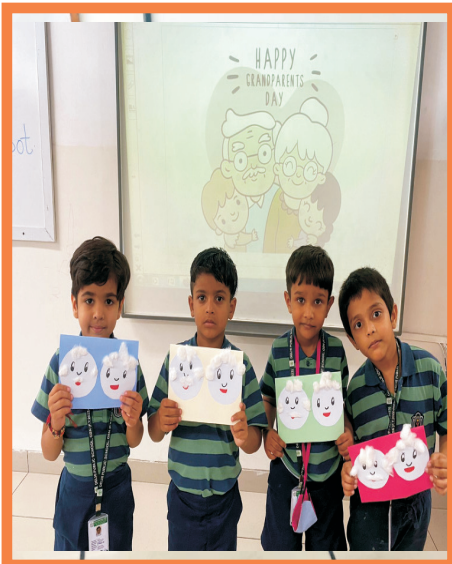

LITTLE HANDS AT WORK ACTIVITY

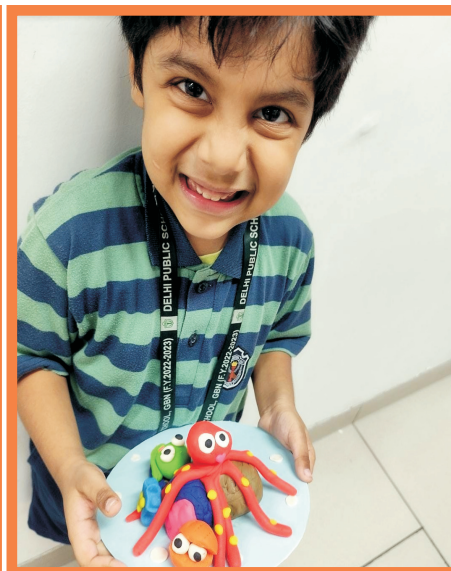

CLAY MODELLING COMPETITION

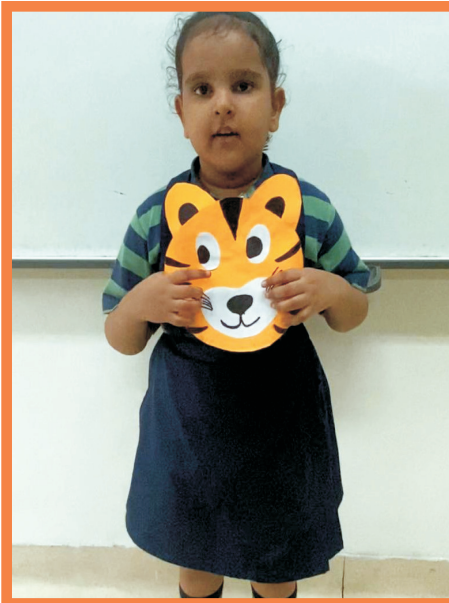
